

# FA Education Licensing Requirements 2017/2018

## Affiliate Tutor Coach Education

### FA Level 1 and FA Level 2 in Coaching Football



#### Tutor purpose:

Ensure effective delivery of FA Education courses, specifically the FA Level 1 in Coaching Football and FA Level 2 in Coaching Football. Work closely with the County FA and County Coach Developer in contributing to a consistent learner experience across the coaching pathway and associated courses within the county. Deliver good quality learning sessions that deliver content in a dynamic and inspiring manner.

#### Key accountabilities as a licensed tutor:

- Deliver FA Education in the manner intended and in line with the FA Affiliate Tutor Principles of Practice.
- Demonstrate high expectations of yourself and learners ensuring a positive learning experience for all.
- Maintain correct and timely records of learner attendance and achievement.
- Provide individualised support for learners, as designed by the course, to maximise learner potential and drive progression.
- Commit to continual professional development, supporting quality processes and maintaining an individual Tutor Action Plan.
- Maintain mandatory training requirements, ensuring they are in date at all times.

#### Essential requirements of a licensed tutor:

- FA Level 3 (UEFA B) in Coaching Football.
- Completion of FA Tutor Training (GTT or DDT) or commitment to complete in the 2017/2018 season.
- Experience of delivering to adults in an education setting.
- Experience of assessment in the workplace or formal educational settings.
- Understanding of the FA Learning Cycle and England DNA.
- Competent use of learning technology.
- Understanding of the long term player development model (LTPD); Social, Psychological, Technical, Physical.

#### Desirable requirements of a licensed tutor:

- FA Youth Award Module 1.
- FA Youth Award Module 2.
- FA Youth Award Module 3.
- FA Youth Award.
- Actively working with players in a coaching capacity within the last 12 months.
- Experience of responding to the developmental needs of individual coaches.

#### Tutor licence specifics:

	FA Level 1 in Coaching Football	FA Level 2 in Coaching Football
<b>Minimum delivery requirements</b>	Must commit to a minimum of 28 days delivery per season. Delivery must include a combination of FA Level 1 and FA Level 2 in Coaching Football courses, not just one level in isolation.	
<b>Fees</b>	£550 per course delivery, inclusive of expenses. Delivery includes online elements and face to face delivery.	£2500 per course delivery, inclusive of expenses. Delivery includes pre course organisation, face to face delivery, journal reviews and in situ support.
<b>Delivery Pattern</b>	7 workshops of learning, 3.5 days, a total of 28-30 hours.	3 blocks, delivered in a 4 day, 3 day, 3 day model with flexibility around delivery design but equivalent to 10 days of delivery. In situ assessments outside of the 10 days of delivery.
<b>Tutor Ratio</b>	1:18	1:12 with best practice being 2:24
<b>Course content</b>	Face to face delivery, online content.	Face to face delivery, online content, in situ support visits.
<b>Professional development</b>	On- going bespoke development activity based on feedback from quality assurance processes and your Tutor Action Plan.	
<b>Mandatory training</b>	In date FA CRC, Safeguarding Children and Level 2 Emergency First Aid in Football (EFAiF) or in date Level 4 Intermedicate Trauma Medical Management in Football (ITMMIF)	
<b>Kit</b>	Tutor training kit will be provided to you and should be worn during all course delivery.
