- Maintain correct and timely records of learner attendance and achievement.

- Commit to continual professional development, supporting quality processes and maintaining an individual Tutor Action Plan.
- Maintain mandatory training requirements, ensuring they are in date at all times.

Understanding of the long term player development model (LTPD); Social, Psychological, Technical, Physical.
