

Registering for the 2021/2022 Season.

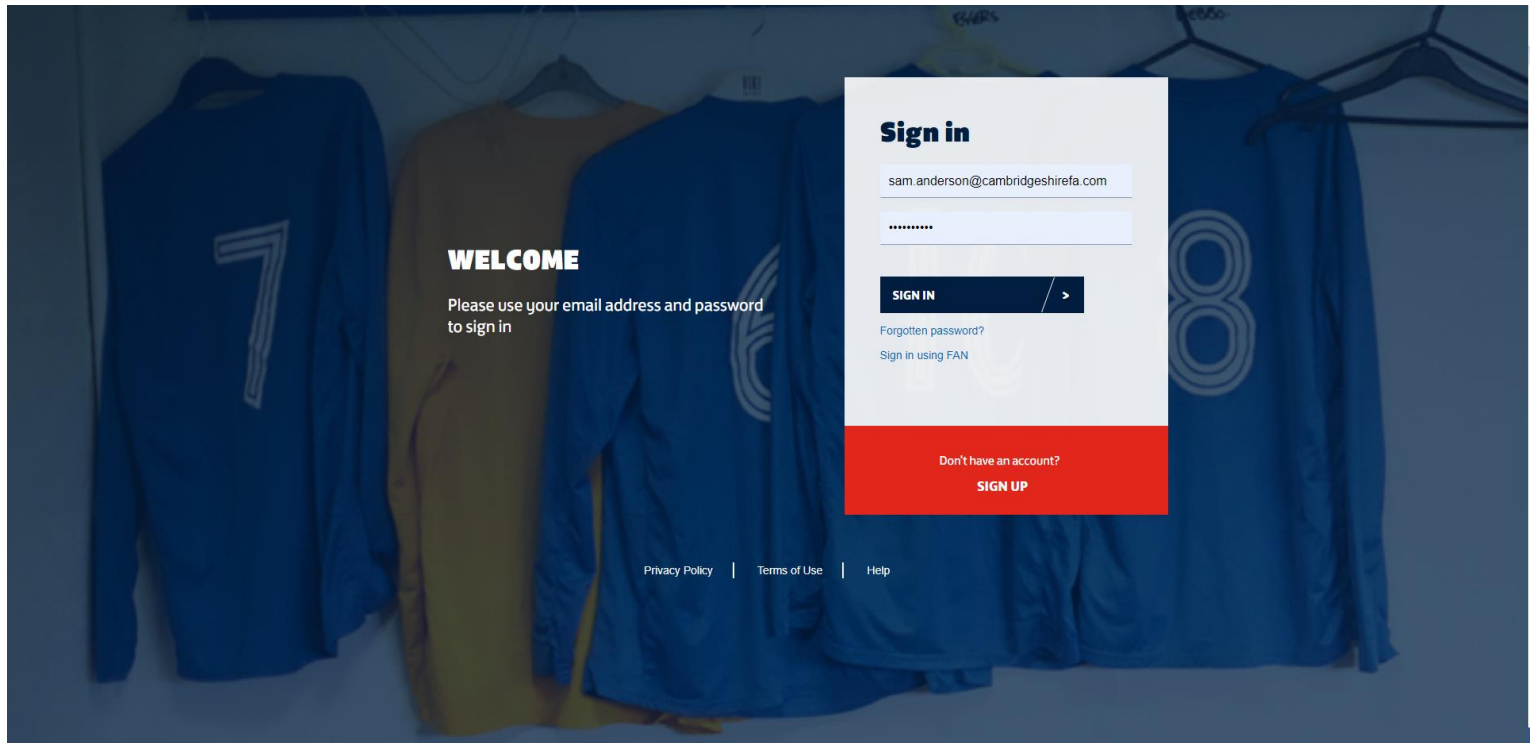
Referee Registration has opened on the 1st June 2021. This year, additional requirements are required for match officials. All officials, now require an in date Safeguarding Qualification. All referees or parents/carers of referees will have received an email on Monday 31st May with information on what is required. If you can't find this, please email referees@cambridgeshirefa.com for advise on what is required.
