In both the men's and women's game, Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic coaches continue to be significantly underrepresented.

The FA, Cheshire FA and Manchester FA are committed to changing that. We're committed to developing more opportunities for Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic coaches to get experience, support and guidance to enhance coaching skills and discover pathways into and within the game of football.

As part of our Diversity & Inclusion coach development work, in partnership Cheshire FA and Manchester FA will be providing up to 30 young coaches from historically underrepresented backgrounds and females with an opportunity to become a member of the 2022-23 Future Coaches.

## BLACK, ASIAN AND MINORITY ETHNIC CLASSIFICATION



The FA adopts Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic classifications to refer to members of communities who identify as being Black, Asian, from Mixed/Multiple Ethnic Groups or from other Ethnic Groups as per the England and Wales Census ethnicity classifications.

This is consistent with the Oxford English dictionary definition of Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic and the ONS definition of Ethnic Minority.
