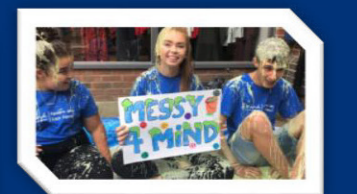

The squad is integrated into the Football Development & Support Centre, based at Staplewood Campus which is also home to the club's Premier League men's side and world-famous Academy.

Marieanne Spacey-Cale MBE was appointed as Head Coach/ Head of Girls' & Women's Football in July 2018; as a UEFA Pro License holder, with extensive playing experience at the very top of the women's game and 91 caps for England Women, Marieanne is perfectly positioned to further Saints ambition to continue producing home-grown international standard female players, as well as achieving Southampton FC's future goal of competing in the FA Women's Championship in the coming years.

I think they’ve had a good season and recently a good few friendlies. They will be strong but a challenge we’ll really embrace.

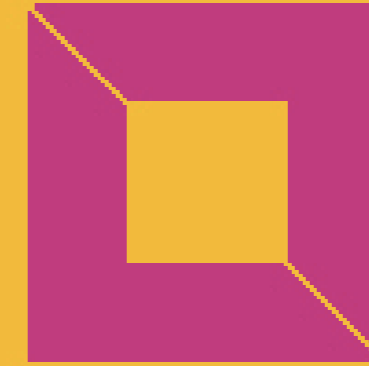
The last meeting was competitive, but we showed what we could do and the level we want to get at. This fixture is another occasion to show that level and beyond.

PORTSMOUTH FC LADIES



CLUB HISTORY

Portsmouth Football Club Ladies was officially founded in 1987, although a women's team in the city can be traced all the way back to the 1930s.

In 1998, Pompey gained promotion into the South West Combination League, a league they were to play in the next few seasons. Pompey won the South West Combination League in style in 2003, dropping just two points in the process and entered the Women's Premier League Southern Division for the first time. Pompey quickly became acquainted with their new surroundings, finishing second behind Chelsea within a couple of seasons of joining the league.

After winning The FA Women's Premier League Southern Division title at the end of the 2011/12 season, the first team secured promotion to the National Division for the first time in the club's history. This season saw the Blues reach the Semi-Finals of the Premier League Cup before losing to eventual winners Aston Villa.

Manager Vanessa Raynbird stood down as manager and Katie Poore and Perry Northeast became joint managers for the 2013/14 season. Following the introduction of the Women's Super League, Pompey found themselves back in the Premier League Southern Division for the 2013/14 season.

Despite losing on the opening day to Cardiff, Pompey went on to lose only once more and won the league. In the Play Off it was level after 90 minutes, but a 93rd-minute goal from Sheffield United crushed Pompey's hopes.

The 2015/16 season was a difficult one for the Blues as they prepared to defend their Premier League crown. Players were leaving the club including top goal scorer Ini Umotong and there was a valiant effort in which they were still in with a chance at the title until three games to go.

The end of the season saw the departure of Manager Perry Northeast who had won four trophies with the Blues and got them to the quarter-finals of the FA Women's Cup. Pompey appointed former Watford Ladies Development Coach Craig Taylor as the new manager in 2016. However, in the November he stepped down and was replaced by Jay Sadler.

MEET THE TEAM

Hannah Haughton
Goalkeeper, Hannah Haughton, joined Pompey in December 2018, signing from Southampton Saints, where she played for 13 years of her career. She made her debut on January 6, 2019, helping the Blues to a 1-0 win over Queens Park Rangers. The goalkeeper also picked up the 'Players' Player' award for the 2019/20 season.

Rebekah Tonks
Rebekah Tonks is currently in her third year of her second spell at the Blues. She made her second debut for the club against Coventry United in September 2018. The central defender made her 50th appearance for the club in a 4-0 win over MK Dons in 2019, and at the end of that season won the 'Young Player' award.

Rosie McDonnell
Rosie McDonnell signed for Pompey in October 2019. She made her debut away to Keynsham Town, assisting three of Pompey's seven goals. The left-wing back scored her first goal for the club just five days after she joined. Her first strike helped the Blues to a 4-1 victory over Chichester City. Rosie is a Leading Nurse in the Royal Navy and is based at QA Hospital. She's been working tirelessly hard on the frontline, helping people during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Danielle Rowe - Vice-Captain
Danielle Rowe signed for Pompey in the summer of 2018 and is a central midfielder. She made her debut for the club in the 6-0 victory over C&K Basildon in the first game of the 2018/19 campaign. She scored the first goal in the 2019 Hampshire Cup final, helping the Blues to their 15th trophy.

Laura Ingram
Laura Ingram signed for Pompey in the summer of 2019, joining from local side Chichester City. The defender made her debut on the opening day of the 2019/20 campaign against Watford. Her first goal for the club came in the Blues' 3-2 League Cup victory over Gillingham.

Jazz Younger
Jazmin Younger signed for Pompey in the summer of 2018. She made her debut in Pompey's 4-1 victory over Gillingham at the PMC Stadium that season. The defender grabbed

her first goal for the club in December 2019 against Leyton Orient in the FA Cup during a stint as a striker.

Jade Widdows
Jade Widdows signed for Pompey in March 2019 from Chichester City. She made her debut for the club against MK Dons a few days later. The forward is a great ambassador for Pompey Women, having completed many different talks in schools and colleges in partnership with the University of Portsmouth.

Jade Bradley - Captain
Captain, Jade Bradley, signed for Pompey in the summer of 2018. She made her debut in the 6-0 victory over C&K Basildon. Her first goal came in the game after against Gillingham, where she was also named Player of the Match. At the start of the 2019/20 season, she was named vice-captain, taking the armband for five games during the campaign. Following Amelia Southgate's retirement, head coach Jay Sadler appointed the midfielder as captain.

Katie James
Katie James has been at Pompey since 2013. She made her first team debut against Coventry in 2014. Alongside football, Katie competes in various beach soccer tournaments, and represented Team GB at the beach Olympic games in 2019.

Becki Bath
Becki Bath signed for Pompey in December 2018. Her first goal came in the Blues' dramatic nine-goal thriller against Watford. She finished joint top-scorer of the 2019/20 season alongside Charmaine True and Jade Widdows.

Hayley Bridge
Hayley Bridge signed for Pompey in the summer of 2019. She made her debut in Pompey's first game of the 2019/20 campaign against Watford. Her first goal came in the last game of the campaign against Oxford United.

Ava Rowbotham
Ava Rowbotham joined Pompey in March 2020, after signing on a dual-registration deal from Championship side Lewes. In August 2020, the deal was made permanent as she was announced as the Blues' first summer signing.

Charmaine True
Charmaine True is currently in her second spell at Pompey. She left the Reserve team in 2018 and made the move to Crystal Palace. She re-joined the club back in August 2019, announced as Jay Sadler's first signing of the summer. Her first Pompey goal in her second spell at the Blues was against Hounslow.

Kat Cunningham
Katherine Cunningham was the Blues' second signing of the 2020 summer transfer window. She spent two years at Reading's WSL Academy before leaving to join the Blues.

Abi Mason
Abi Mason was the third and final signing of the summer, joining from Brighton & Hove Albion's U23 side. She's appeared in seven of Pompey's games this season in defence and midfield.

Shannon Albuery
Shannon Albuery is currently in her third stint at the club having signed from today's opponents in October. She scored against Southampton when the two teams met in this competition in 2019.

Mia Adaway
Mia Adaway has come all the way through the development pathway at Pompey. She started out from U10 and has progressed all the way into the first team, signing on in the summer of 2019. She scored her first goal against Oxford United.

Eilidh Currie

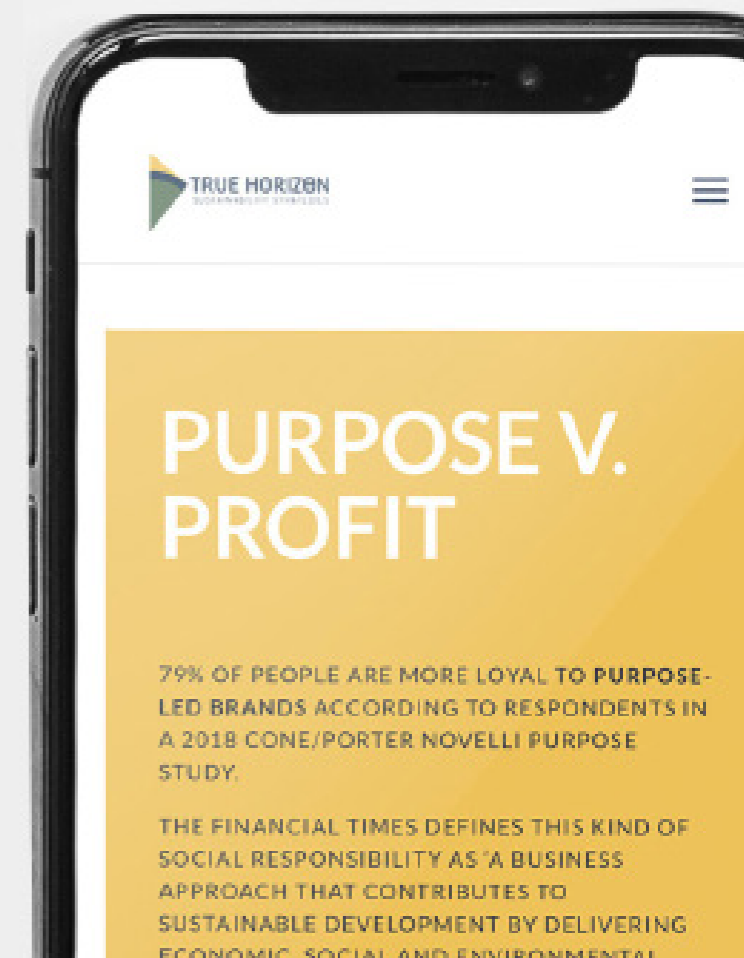

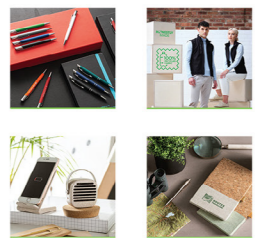

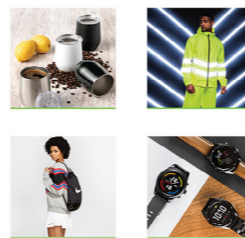
