Government Funding

Sport England Emergency Funds

Sport England have announced a Community Emergency Fund with grants between £300-£10,000 for those most in need within sport. This application process is open to football clubs who find themselves in need of funding.

Comic Relief Community Funding

Launched in March 2020, this funding is to support organisations looking to deliver on one of the four strategic targets for Comic Relief. These are:

- Children survive and thrive targeted at under 5s
- Fighting for gender justice improving inequality for females or those exploited due to their gender
- A Safe Place to Be Looking to rebuild lives for the homeless or those involved in forced migration
- Mental Health Matters supporting good mental health in your communities.

Capacity building grants (up to £500) and Project Delivery Grants (up to £4000) are currently available.
