

#### **METHOD**

Online survey fielded May-July 2023.

Promoted via emails from The FA, through social media channels, and at the in-person events.

Respondents chose which modules and questions to answer from the following list of topics:

- Playing the game
- Referees & match officials
- Coaching
- Volunteering
- Technology & communication
- Behaviours
- Cost of living
- The future of youth football

21,339 responses

ranging from 2,849 (Referees & match officials) to 14,084 (Playing the game) per module





#### **London FA Consultation**



#### Phase 1: Four stakeholder consultation sessions:

- 3 in-person/1 online
- 153 people engaged
- Questions focused on London FA & FA strategic priorities, London landscape and challenges, possible solutions, and brand and identity

#### Phase 2: E-survey out to all consultation attendees

- 50 responses
- Questions focused on three areas creating thriving communities, connecting and serving participants, progressing the games governance

#### Phase 3: Board Strategy Away Day

 Did an exercise to prioritise the actions and ideas accumulated from consultations – must, should, could, won't

#### Before Affiliation Window Opens (75% of work)

- 1) Check officials and qualifications
- 2) Add club and team grounds
- 3) Read and accept Safeguarding declarations (once per season)
- 4) Tidy up folded teams
- 5) Assign teams to correct leagues

#### From 5th June

- 6) Create new teams
- 7) Affiliate teams as required
- 8) Add County Cups

### WITH THE AFFILIATION PERIOD SOON TO BE UPON US, GET AFFILIATION READY SO YOUR CLUB IS PREPARED TO CLICK SUBMIT ONCE THE AFFILIATION WINDOW OPENS!

There are some new requirements which are important for our clubs to start preparing for now so you can be ready for the upcoming season.

Opening from Wednesday 5th June 2024, club affiliation will again be available in **Club Portal** instead of through the Whole Game System.

#### Affiliation Requirements for the 24-25 season

#### All Clubs

- Public Liability Insurance All clubs are required to have Public Liability Insurance covering the club for the upcoming year.
   This must be a minimum of £10million pounds.
- Club Ground It is a requirement for clubs to state their main home ground. You can do this ahead of affiliation through the 'My
  Club' tab. You can find guidance on how to complete this here.





### Accreditation – Becoming an Accredited Club

#### What is England Football Accreditation?

- England Football Accreditation replaced The FA Charter Standard as the new framework for Club & League Accreditation.
- A vibrant national Club & League network that delivers inclusive Football for its local community.
- An opportunity for The FA and County FA to recognise Clubs & Leagues who raise standards and maximise opportunities for all to participate.
- To keep Football accessible, sustainable and safe, helping those to successfully run football off and on the pitch.
- Ensures provision centres around the Respect standards and behaviours needed to make Football a place for all.





### Accreditation – Becoming an Accredited Club

#### **Rewards and Recognition**

- Funding for facility improvements.
- Access to the Club Programme and professional services.
- Access to experts: Mentors, Ambassadors and Club Consultants.
- Invitations to webinars, events and conferences.
- County Recognition.
- Opportunity to win National Awards.
- Opportunity to win County FA Awards.
- Developmental support to grow provision.
- EFA Benefits: Nike Footballs, Welcome Pack, Asset Pack, Certificate.





### Accredited Club

#### To be a one star Accredited Club, you must:

Offer a minimum of one affiliated male or female team at any age group playing within an FA sanctioned League competition. Or a minimum of one affiliated disability team.\*

\*Affiliated disability teams, will be recognised and do not need to be playing within a sanctioned competition.

### Accredited Club \*

#### To be a two star Accredited Club, you must:

Offer a complete Accredited player pathway for either male or female or disability football, playing within FA sanctioned League competitions.\*

In addition, offer a minimum of one team at any age group from an alternative pathway.

\*Affiliated disability teams, will be recognised and do not need to be playing within a sanctioned competition.

Offer the complete accredited player pathway for both male and female whilst offering a minimum of one disability team at any age group, playing within FA sanctioned League competitions.\*
