

METHOD

Online survey fielded May-July 2023.

Promoted via emails from The FA, through social media channels, and at the in-person events.

Respondents chose which modules and questions to answer from the following list of topics:

- Playing the game
- Referees & match officials
- Coaching
- Volunteering
- Technology & communication
- Behaviours
- Cost of living
- The future of youth football

21,339 responses

ranging from 2,849 (Referees & match officials) to 14,084 (Playing the game) per module





London FA Consultation



Phase 1: Four stakeholder consultation sessions:

- 3 in-person/1 online
- 153 people engaged
- Questions focused on London FA & FA strategic priorities, London landscape and challenges, possible solutions, and brand and identity

Phase 2: E-survey out to all consultation attendees

- 50 responses
- Questions focused on three areas creating thriving communities, connecting and serving participants, progressing the games governance

Phase 3: Board Strategy Away Day

 Did an exercise to prioritise the actions and ideas accumulated from consultations – must, should, could, won't

- Opening on 10th June 2024, with rules submitted via the Whole Game System
- Competition structure is completed in the Competitions Portal (competitions.thefa.com)
- Fees same as last season (£50 league sanctioning fee, £20 Public Liability Insurance).
- Fees same as last season with £12 per league cup run by the league, will be added to your invoice
- Reviewing of the rules will be split between both staff and committee members.



Competition Portal Updates

- Safeguarding qualifications are now included on the "qualifications" filter in League, team & club officials tabs.
- Easily view Key Officials, All Officials and any required missing key officials on one page.
- View up-to-date contact information for all league officials.
- Send qualification reminders to league officials who are required to complete outstanding courses.
- Club officials, Team Officials and League officials now all monitored within the same portal.
- League officials can now be added via Competition portal. Thus the League officials tab removed from WGS Portal.
- Sanctioning Association & Competition Type is displayed in the competition header.
- Users can now upload copies of their competition rules to the new "Competition Rules" sub tab and also upload AGM Minutes & League Accounts.
- Season added in header on Competitions/Players tab pages.
- The name of the season is added to aid users through the "Season rollover" period.

- 1) Check officials and qualifications
- 2) Add club and team grounds
- 3) Read and accept Safeguarding declarations (once per season)
- 4) Tidy up folded teams
- 5) Assign teams to correct leagues

From 5th June

- 6) Create new teams
- 7) Affiliate teams as required
- 8) Add County Cups

There are some new requirements which are important for our clubs to start preparing for now so you can be ready for the upcoming season.

Opening from Wednesday 5th June 2024, club affiliation will again be available in Club Portal instead of through the Whole Game System.

Affiliation Requirements for the 24-25 season

All Clubs

- Public Liability Insurance All clubs are required to have Public Liability Insurance covering the club for the upcoming year. This must be a minimum of £10million pounds.
- Club Ground It is a requirement for clubs to state their main home ground. You can do this ahead of affiliation through the 'My Club' tab. You can find guidance on how to complete this here.

ENGLAND FOOTBALL ACCREDITATION (Leagues)



League Accreditation

Criteria

- Must have 60% of Teams with the Club Accreditation award when first applying, then have 3 years to reach a minimum of 85% of Teams.
- A sanctioned League.
- The League has its own bank account.
- The League has Accreditation on its League agenda and minutes.
- The League has signed up to The Football Leadership Diversity Code.
- Links to another League if not offering a full player pathway.
- Completed Delivery Plan agreed by the League and County FA.

- 3) S.W.O.T Analysis
- 4) Upcoming season initiatives (minimum 5) Safeguarding, Respect, Equality & Diversity, Technology, Attracting/Retaining/Engaging Players, Volunteer Workforce, Supporting League Officials, Refereeing (Recruitment, Retention, Support), Comms & Marketing, Coaching.
- 5) County FA support
- 6) Declaration
