On the season, clearly the stop/start caused disruption, however the players kept themselves fit. We lost 1 game prior to the league ending and expected to have a successful season.

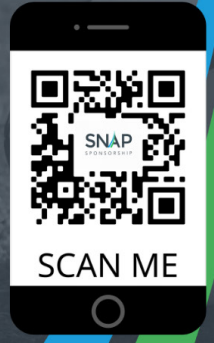

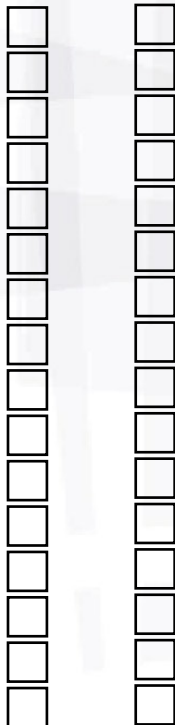
