## **Role Description**

The Middlesex FA Youth Council are looking for members aged 16-24 years for the 2023/24 season to represent young people across the county and help put into action the Middlesex FA strategy. Appointed individuals will require the appropriate skills, knowledge, and experience to have a positive and meaningful impact on football within Middlesex. The Youth Council will work together to give young people a voice within football and to identify and deliver projects aimed at enhancing football participation across Middlesex.

## Responsibilities

Being a member of Middlesex FA Youth Council can include (but is not limited to):

- Organising and running of football events.
- Supporting County FA-led events and programmes.
- Help shape opportunities for young people within the county.
- Attending Youth Council meetings (monthly).
- Creation and implementation of social media campaigns.
- Impact on Middlesex FA's strategy.
- Further opportunities can include supporting FA and UEFA events.
