As Chairman of the Norfolk County Football Association, it gives me great pleasure to welcome you all to Harrod Sport Arena for our 2025 Cup Final Series. This afternoon is the second of our fourteen County Cup Finals as we host the Norfolk Intermediate Cup Final.

The first of the two sides competing for the trophy is this afternoon's home side, Attleborough Town Reserves. They currently compete in the Anglian Combination League, Division 4 North. Their opponents are Dussindale & Hellesdon Rovers A Team, who also compete in the Anglian Combination, Division 4. The last time these two sides met was in the league at the beginning of March, with Attleborough Town Reserves coming out victorious on this occasion, winning 2-0.


Attleborough Town Reserves currently sit 4th in the table, with 11 wins, 3 draws and 4 loses. Their route to the final consisted of a 4-2 win vs Easton A in the second round, a walk-over in the quarter finals vs KLSC Reserves and a 5-1 win vs Madra in the semi-final.

Dussindale & Hellesdon Rovers A team currently sit one place above Attleborough Town Reserves in 3rd place, with 11 wins, 5 draws and 2 loses. Their route to the final consisted of a 2-1 win over 21/22 champions, UEA A, a comprehensive 6-0 vs Watlington Reserves in the quarter-final and a 3-2 win vs Norton Athletic Reserves in the semi-final.

The third team on show for today's spectacle will of course be the match officials. They, like the teams have also earned the right to be here, and I would like to extend my congratulations to them on their selection. I wish them every success in what I hope will be a memorable occasion for all involved.

Finally, a thank you to all our Board, Ex-Council and Youth Council members who are present together with staff from HQ and our FDCs for their hard work coming together to stage our fourteen 2025 County Cup Finals.

THE NORFOLK INTERMEDIATE CUP

The Norfolk Intermediate Cup was introduced in the 2021/22 season, for Saturday clubs who have two or more eligible teams competing at Junior Level in Norfolk, with the lower ranked team competing in the Norfolk Intermediate Cup.

The third season of the Norfolk Intermediate Cup saw eighteen teams enter. Finalists, Earsham Reserves, did not manage two back-to-back finals, falling short against Shrublands Reserves 1-0. semi-final The other Dersingham Rovers Reserves host Dussindale & Hellesdon Rovers 'A'. A game that took 90 minutes and a penalty shoot-out to separate the sides which eventually saw Dersingham Rovers Reserves win 6-5, meaning Dersingham Rovers Reserves and Shrublands Reserves were our 23-24 Intermediate Finalists. It was Dersingham Rovers Reserves who lifted the Intermediate Cup after a convincing 3-0 victory against a hard-working Shrublands Reserves side.

Today's first finalists, Attleborough Town Reserves, already have their name etched on the Norfolk Intermediate Cup back in the 22-23 season, so they will be looking to double their tally of Norfolk Intermediate Cup titles. Today's second finalists, Dussindale & Hellesdon Rovers 'A', will be looking to lift the trophy for the first time having previously tasted County Cup success in 2018 when they lifted the Norfolk Junior Cup.
