NORFOLK U18'S REACH FA COUNTY YOUTH CUP FINAL FOR THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR

Norfolk reach this year's FA County Youth Cup Final by beating Essex thanks to two quickfire goals in the first half.

Essex started the stronger of the two sides and came very close to taking the lead early on. Norfolk goalkeeper, Reuben Lane, came to his team's rescue with a smart reaction save down to his right after the ball was fired at goal from close range.

Although Norfolk were dominating possession, neither side created any meaningful chances until the deadlock was broken in the 32nd minute when Tom Baird converted a penalty as he hit the ball into the bottom left corner from 12 yards out.



Norfolk doubled their lead less than two minutes later after Tom Pipe latched onto an excellent through ball from the left-hand side by Dyson and drilled a low cross to the front post. 
