



UPDATE KEY TRENDS

POSITIVITY IS WINNING

A huge majority (89.6%) of matches have been played where the average Respect scores across all measures were 8-10 out of 10, compared to the 1.2% of matches where the average match Respect Mark was 5 or less.

HOME VS AWAY:

Respect Mark scores are higher for home teams than away teams. 89.3% of home teams were scored a Respect Mark of 8-10 across players, coaches, and spectators, compared with 84.6% of away teams. The percentage of away teams being scored 1-3 Respect Marks is 2.6% which is double that of home teams.

INFLUENCE OF THE COACH?:

Where coaches were scored 5 or less for respect, their players' respect marks fell well below the average (8.75). When only counting players' respect marks for teams whose coaches scored 5 or less, the players' average score drops to 5.2 out of 10, compared to 9.4 out of 10 when the coach was scored 8-10.

INFLUENCE OF THE SPECTATOR?:

Where spectators were scored 5 or less for respect, their players' respect marks fell even further below the average. When only counting players' respect marks for teams whose spectators scored 5 or less, the players' average Respect Mark drops to 4.6 out of 10 compared with 9 out of 10 when spectators were scored 8-10.
