COUNTY CUPS

We deliver a wide range of prestigious County Cup competitions, including the historic Oxfordshire FA Senior Cup which was first contested in the 1884/1885 season and includes English Football League, FA National League System and Regional Feeder League teams.

Our County Cup competitions kick off in October and run through to the local finals in May and June. They provide high-profile promotional opportunities throughout that period and include adult male and female first teams, reserve teams, youth teams for boys and girls from ages 13 to 18, and players aged 35 or over as well as our Sunday Cup and Charity Cup.

WOMEN'S FOOTBALL Gold Partnership Package

There has never been a more exciting time to be involved in the women's game in Oxfordshire, with the game growing from strength to strength!

In Oxfordshire, we have 1,000 players participating in over 50 affiliated teams in grassroots football within our local club network.

We also have five FA Just Play providers offering a recreational football offer for women aged over 18.

These are providing fun, social and inclusive opportunities for women that have never played before or might have stopped playing in the past.

We are proud to have so many success stories of girls progressing through our county football pathways to represent their country as well as play professionally, including England U23 and Birmingham City's Lucy Thomas and Leicester City's Demi Lambourne.

With the success of the Lionesses helping to supercharge growth we







have an exciting future ahead, but there is more we want to achieve and with your help we can make this happen.

DISABILITY FOOTBALL Gold Partnership Package

There has never been a more exciting time to be involved in the disability game in Oxfordshire.

We have 230 players with disabilities participating in 24 affiliated teams in grassroots football. The county also have four active FA Comets sessions which are recreational opportunities for 5 to 11-year olds. We work closely with the Berkshire, Oxfordshire and Buckinghamshire (BOBi) League which is one of the biggest PAN Disability Leagues in the country. We are also making progress with PAN disability sessions, and impairment specific sessions with Powerchair, Down Syndrome, and Cerebral Palsy provision opportunities.

However, we want to push this even further and provide all children, young people, and adults with a disability a local opportunity to participate.







These opportunities are changing the lives of many people across the county - so join forces with us to help double the number of children and adults with disabilities playing football in Oxfordshire.

- Grow the number of FA Comets Programmes in the county to provide children aged from 5 to 11 with a positive introduction to football
- Allow us to invest more time into our FA Disability Football Ambassador programme to increase the number of grassroots clubs providing inclusive sessions in the county
- Grow the number of youth and adult affiliated teams participating in the BOBi League
- Increase the number of wellbeing sessions in the county.
- Provide mental health guidance and support to our grassroots club and league network
- Provide more opportunities for disability players to play football in their local area

WALKING FOOTBALL Gold Partnership Package

Walking Football is exactly as the name suggests. It has seen the biggest growth in participation and impact on activity, health and wellbeing amongst people aged 50 years and older in Oxfordshire with similar trends across the country.

Usually aimed at people over 50, this inclusive, fun and sociable 5-a-side version of the game is slow-paced but still contains the same passion and excitement of the original game.

We are proud to have a number of opportunities for older people to participate in local recreational sessions and competitively through the Oxfordshire Walking Football League. The league has opportunities for the over 50s, 60s and most recently a midweek over 70s offer.

There are over 15 sessions across the county offering turn-up-andplay opportunities aimed to be fun, inclusive, sociable and have a positive impact on health and wellbeing. We also have the impressive Oxfordshire Over 50s League which plays throughout the season.







They have recently introduced a an aged 60 and over division which has extended opportunities further. Despite the significant growth over the past couple of years, we are really excited about the opportunities to grow the Walking Football game even further county-wide and engage new audiences.

Help us positively engage with older people in the county to tackle loneliness, mental health and inactivity.

- Support our grassroots clubs network to create teams to enter the Oxfordshire Over 50s League
- Provide more opportunities for older people to play football in their local area



COACH DEVELOPMENT Gold Partnership Package

Across our network of 200 local football clubs we have over 1,600 affiliated coaches who we support through the delivery of a comprehensive coach development programme culminating in an annual coaches conference.

This programme is designed to upskill our coaching workforce to provide a fun, safe, inclusive and enjoyable experience for all players in Oxfordshire. As part of our offer, with the aim of diversifying our coach workforce, we provide bespoke events for female coaches and diverse ethnic communities.

We are also developing a new Coaches Club which will allow us to create an inclusive coaching community to share good practice and support each other's development county wide.

We are proud of our coach development offer but we want to take this to the next level.
