

The aim is to give young individuals a first chance on the ladder of the Football Coaching and Referee Courses, so that they can develop their individual skills and put them to good use locally within the Football fraternity.

A Certificate is awarded to all recipients and on completion of the Course the Bursary is awarded.

For Referee Course individual will get their second year Referee Registration fee included.

HOW MUCH IS AVAILABLE?

Grants cover a proportion of the course cost and are considered on a case by case basis

IS PARTNERSHIP FUNDING REQUIRED?

Applicants are required to cover the remainder of the course fee

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Referee applicants must reside in the local authority areas of either Cherwell, Oxford, South Oxfordshire or West Oxfordshire.

WHO IS IT FOR?

- Aspiring coaches aged between 16 and 19 who are members of Oxfordshire FA affiliated clubs
- Aspiring referees aged between 14 and 19 living within the Oxfordshire FA boundaries.
- A Bursary is now offered towards Referee Kit to help Young Referees.
- The Trustees Have Now Expanded The Criteria To Include Adult Referees Coming Into The Game. Bursaries Will Be Given To Those Who Successfully Apply And Stay With Their Respective League For The Season.
