COUNTY CUP FINALS 2023

Last season we had a couple of occasions where pyrotechnics, flares and smoke devices were brought to games.

It is important to highlight that these items are not only illegal inside a football stadium, but these prohibited items can also cause great harm to people.

If this happens again we will look to get pictures of those involved which will be passed to the police for prosecution and if identified will be barred from football in any form in the County.

These pyrotechnics and flares can burn at up to 2,000°C and can cause significant injuries to carriers and fellow spectators.

There have been a number of reported incidents that have resulted in people experiencing breathing difficulties, distress and discomfort. The potential injuries sustained as a result of someone using a pyrotechnic include:

- Serious injuries, such as loss of limb or fingers
- Severe burns, due to temperatures of up to 2,000°C
- Breathing problems, due to smoke inhalation
- Loss of hearing or sight, because of the explosive power

Welcome to the Oxfordshire FA Intermediate Cup Final and a special welcome to the supporters of both teams.

After a season of traditional British weather – snow and rain – football seems to be back to normal and being enjoyed everywhere by many.

The Intermediate Cup was first contested in the 1952/53 season where Kidlington took the inaugural title and went on to win another four times with their last title coming in 2019. Woodcote are the current holders following a 1-0 victory over Easington Sports last season. Thame United Reserves hold the record for the most titles with seven last winning the competition in 2014.

Looking at today's finalists Oxford City, who knocked out Charlton United Reserves in this season's semi-final stage, have six Intermediate Cup titles to their name last winning the competition in 2017 with a 4-2 extra-time victory over Berinsfield.

Headington Amateurs recorded their only Intermediate Cup win in the 2007/08 season courtesy of their reserve team who beat Kidlington Reserves 2-1.

They played in the Oxford City Junior League until the 1960's when they moved up to the Oxfordshire Senior League. They joined the Hellenic League in 1988 when their Committee joined forces with the old Morris Motors Committee. After competing for many years at Premier & Division One level ground grading has meant Headington now play in Division Two. Headington moved to their present location at Barton (now Barton Park) some 30 years ago.

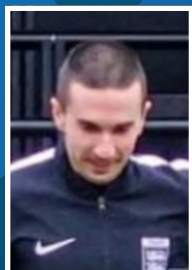
