- Contribute to Worcestershire FA's delivery of an effective safeguarding plan, including the Safeguarding Operating
 Standard
- Contribute to ensuring that Safeguarding and Equality are embedded throughout Worcestershire FA and within grassroots football by having an understanding of risks and responsibilities relating to activities
- Comply with FA rules, regulations, policies, procedures and guidance that are in place from time to time

WHAT WE CAN OFFER

Our Youth Network was previously called the Youth Council. Many previous members of our Youth Council have gone on to get full-time jobs within football or used the skills they have developed as part of the group to find employment elsewhere. There may be opportunities to progress across the County FA Network throughout England and at The FA with access to high-quality training, networking and personal development opportunities. National volunteering opportunities are also available to Youth Network members.

Most importantly, you will have the chance to support the development of football in Worcestershire with a focus on improving the grassroots experience for young people.

SAFEGUARDING

We are committed to safeguarding children and adults at risk. Due to the nature of this role, the successful candidate will be required to undertake a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check through The FA DBS process. The possession of a criminal record will not necessarily prevent an applicant from obtaining this post, as all cases are judged individually according to the nature of the role and the information provided. The successful candidate will also be required to undertake a safeguarding induction and safeguarding training as outlined by the FA.
