

The Emirates FA Cup Semi-Final Mascot Competition (“the Competition”)

Terms and Conditions

1. The Terms and Conditions are subject to change without notice at the discretion of The Football Association, by entering this competition you are agreeing to the Terms and Conditions in their current format.
2. The promoter and administrator of the competition is The Football Association Limited (“**The FA**”), Wembley Stadium, Wembley, London HA9 0WS
3. Members of the immediate families of employees of The FA Group are not permitted to enter the Competition.
4. All entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the permission of a parent or guardian before entering the Competition, who must indicate consent by completing the relevant parts of the entry form. For all children’s prizes; children must be between 7-11 years of age on the relevant Fulfilment Date (as defined below).
5. The children’s prize winners will be entitled to a player mascot place at The Emirates FA Cup Semi-Final, which includes three tickets to the fixture. One ticket is for the child and two tickets are for guests (which must include an accompanying adult).
6. To enter the Competition you must be a UK resident and able to attend the events on the Fulfilment Date.
7. The date on which the prizes are fulfilled will be either 22 April or 23 April 2017 (“the **Fulfilment Date**”).
8. The Competition will close at 23:59 on **12 April 2017**.
9. Maximum one entry per entrant.
10. No payment or purchase is necessary to enter the Competition.
11. The FA does not accept responsibility for any entries which are lost, delayed, incomplete or otherwise not received or cannot be entered for technical or any other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt. Incomplete or illegible entries or those not in accordance with the entry instructions and these Terms and Conditions are invalid and The FA reserves the right in its absolute discretion to disqualify such entries or any entrant who it reasonably believes has interfered with the fair running of this competition.
12. The winners will be randomly selected by **15 April 2017** and the decision will be final. In the event of any dispute, the decision of The FA is final.
13. All prizes are non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and not redeemable for cash or other prizes (in whole or in part). In the event of unforeseen circumstances or circumstances outside The FA’s control, The FA reserves the right to offer an alternative prize of equal or greater value or to change the Fulfilment Date. The FA accepts no responsibility for any costs associated with any prize which are not specifically included in that prize. Winners are strictly prohibited from selling their prizes to any other person.
14. The winners of the Competition will be notified by phone by **15 April 2017**. In the event that The FA or the Administrator is not able to contact the competition winner within a reasonable time, a substitute winner may be selected in his/her place.
15. The winners of the Competition agree to comply with the conditions of entry applicable at the Stadium, and shall ensure that those attending with them do so as well. Winners or guests who are rude, abusive or deemed otherwise unsuitable by The FA may be required to leave the Stadium.

16. The winners and their guests at the stadium must not be subject to a football banning order or any other court-issued order which restricts their ability to attend matches and/or makes them unsuitable to attend The Emirates FA Cup Semi-Finals.
17. The Competition winner's prize is non-inclusive of travel and accommodation, prize winners are required to arrange their own travel and accommodation if necessary.
