Wizard-based Functionality

Full-Time is designed to be as intuitive and simple as possible. The majority of tasks are done through a step-by-step 'wizard'.

Fixture Scheduling

Full-Time offers League Administrators multiple ways of creating and maintaining their fixtures. Standard scheduling is division-by-division fixture scheduling. There is an advanced fixture scheduling tool which allows leagues to schedule all divisions at the same time, as well as taking into account ground sharing, pre-defined fixtures and much more. Should you wish to create your fixtures externally to Full-Time, the system offers a fixture upload option. You can also use this option to upload your historical league results from previous seasons into the system.

Respect

The **Respect** Monitoring and Evaluation programme uses the fixture details stored in Full-Time to allow for the online monitoring of Coach/Manager, Player and Spectator behaviour by referees.

Referees use the tools built within the County Websites, to report back on their appointed matches. Using the tools in Full-Time, a League Administrator enters their fixtures and assigns match officials who can then enter their behaviour marks. The FA and County Football Associations can then use this data to monitor behaviour within leagues, clubs and individual teams, while also monitoring the satisfaction of referees.

Using Full-Time with an existing site

Leagues may have spent a lot of time creating their own league websites. Full-Time acts to complement these sites by providing the ability to display fixtures, results and tables, which can be shown on your own site and these will update as you update Full-Time. In other words, you can retain your existing site while benefiting from the functionality of Full-Time.

WAP and SMS Technology

You can access your Full-Time league page via your mobile phone to check on results and table positions with the Full-Time WAP site.

Enabling the Full-Time SMS results submission option, means teams playing in your league can text their results directly into the systems 'results approval area', for an administrator to verify before they appear on the live site. This provides a far more streamlined approach to the normal headache of gathering in weekend results.

People Management

The 'People Management' area of Full-Time gives you the functionality to create players, league officials, referees and managers. For youth leagues there is a variety of specific functionality around date of birth and eligibility. People Management gives you the option of uploading your player records from Excel spreadsheets directly into the system and there is also the ability to merge duplicate records.

System Alerts

As you work within the system the priority list on the admin home page will keep you informed of what else is going on. For example, should you have inadvertently created a fixture clash, the system will alert you and quide you through the process of fixing the problem.
